Text by *St. Thomas Aquinas* (c.1225–1274) from the hymn *Sacris Solemnis*  
Hymn for the office of Corpus Christi and the Most Blessed Sacrament

**Pánis**    **angélicus**    **fit**    **pánis**    **hóminum;**  
[ˈpaː.nis    an.ˈdʒɛː.li.kus    fit    ˈpaː.nis    ˈoː.mi.num]  
Bread    of-the-angels    is-made    the-bread    of-man;  
(*The bread of angels becomes the bread of man;*)

**dat**    **pánis**    **caélicus**    **figúris**    **términum:**  
[dat    ˈpaː.nis    ˈtʃɛː.li.kus    fi.ˈguː.ris    ˈtɛr.mi.num]  
gives    Bread    heavenly    to-forms    an-end;  
(*heavenly bread gives an end to (earthly) forms;*)

O res mirábilis! Mandúcat Dóminum  
páuper, sérvus, et húmilis.

Te trína Déitas, unáque póscimus,  
Sic nos tu vísita, sicut te cólimus;  
Per túas sémitas duc nos quo téndimus,  
Ad lúcem quam inhábitas. Amen.
